Dog Cookie Recipe

2 1/2 c whole wheat flour
1/2 c powdered milk
1t. garlic powder
1T. wheat germ
1t. beef bouillon (granules)
6T. bacon drippings (or meat drippings)
1 egg beaten
1/2c. ice water

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Combine all dry ingredients...Cut in drippings....Mix in egg..Add in enough ice water for mixture to form a ball...Pat into 1/2" thick.

Cut in desired shape (I use a small heart shaped cookie cutter)

Bake for 25-30 minutes on cookie sheet....Cool....Hope you dogs enjoy....
